

Skagit Audubon Society - Youth Funding Program

The Skagit Audubon Society (SAS) is offering financial support to Skagit County students and young adults involved in projects and activities that promote an understanding of the natural world around us. The funding is intended to provide monetary support to individual and/or group projects like high school junior projects, high school senior culmination projects, merit badges, and community outreach activities. The focus of the projects must be on the environment and within the scope of SAS mission statement: "to conserve and restore natural ecosystems, focusing on birds, other wildlife, and their habitats for the benefit of humanity and the earth's biological diversity".

The funding may range from \$50.00 to \$150.00, depending upon the complexity of the request. Students and young adults between the ages of 12 and 21 years and residing in Skagit County are eligible for these funds. The funding is direct financial aid and is being offered in 2011.
